UNACCOMPANIED MINORS – When underage children travel internationally without one or both parents, **the child must travel with a notarized letter from their parents**. Date and sign the notarized letter as close to departure date as possible (recommend within 2 weeks of travel).

First letter is for child traveling with one parent. Second letter is for child traveling without either parent. This is to be used a guide only.

If either parent is deceased, the child is required to travel with a copy of the parent's death certificate. If only one parent has parental rights, the child is required to travel with a copy of the court order showing this. Include this information in the letter if applicable.
