- Swimwear (for beach vacations)
- Small binoculars (for Alaskan cruises)
- Change of clothes in case suitcase is delayed
- Watch/jewelry – try and leave anything worth of value at home
- Expandable bag that can be used to carry items home with you that you purchase on your trip.
- CPAP Machine – Check with your airline for their specific rules regarding anything medical.
