



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DOMESTIC AIR TRAVELERS:

The Federal Real ID Act mandates security standards for state-issued driver's licenses and other forms of identification and prohibits Federal agencies from accepting for official purposes identification that does not meet these standards.

Beginning on **May 3, 2023**, every air traveler will need to present Real ID-compliant identification to be permitted to board a domestic flight; therefore, those holding a non-compliant driver's license will need to present an acceptable alternative form of identification, such as a valid U.S. passport. **A Real ID compliant driver's licenses has a Star in a Circle in the upper right corner.**

To avoid disruption to travel plans, air travelers are strongly encouraged to consult with the Department of Homeland Security (www.dhs.gov/real-id) to determine whether their state issued identification is Real ID-compliant and, if not, what alternate forms of identification will be accepted at the airport.
